



## Installing your sign with standoffs - No template (Exterior)

### **Tools Needed:**

- 1) Drill
- 2) 1/16" drill bit (or similar for drilling a pilot hole)
- 3) Drill bit appropriate for your anchoring system (for drilling wall to insert wall anchors)
- 4) Level
- 5) Wall anchors appropriate for your exterior (**not provided**)
- 6) Phillips head screwdriver
- 7) Allen wrench to tighten standoffs

### ***Installation***

Step 1 - Hold your sign up on the wall, making sure it's level. Mark the holes to be drilled.

Step 2 - Drill out the holes you just marked with a drill bit size appropriate for your wall anchoring system. Insert your wall anchors.

Step 3 - Insert a screw through the female side of the standoffs.

Step 4 - Using a drill with a phillips head, screw the screw with the standoff into the wall anchor. Repeat for all of the mounting points.

Step 5 - Place your sign overtop of the standoffs, and screw the male part of the standoff into the female part.

Step 6 - Using an allen wrench, tighten the screw on the side of the standoff.
